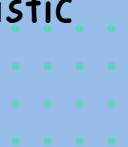
AIS PRE PRIMARY INFLUX



AIIS FOCUS ON PRE PRIMARY EDUCATION



The Early Childhood Period is the most crucial period for the growth and development of the child. It needs the utmost attention and care. The developing child undergoes significant changes and growth in various aspects including physical, cognitive, social, linguistic and emotional development. These are considered domains of development that are evidenced in gradual process of change and differentiation from a simple to a more complex level. AIIS focusses on understanding what children like at different stages of development is crucial for providing appropriate scaffolds and inputs to support their optimal holistic development.





THE MAIN GOAL OF AIS PRE PRIMARY

The main aim of AIS PRE PRIMARY is to provide a foundational educational experience that promotes the overall development of the young children, typically aged 4 to 6.

This includes the following strategies:

Social Skills Development

*Encouraging interaction with peers to develop sharing, cooperation, and conflict resolution skills.

Cognitive Skills & LSRW Skills

*Introducing basic academic concepts such as numbers, letters, shapes, and colours through play-based and hands-on activities.

Independence & Routine

*Teaching children to follow routines, take care of personal belongings, and develop self-help skills.

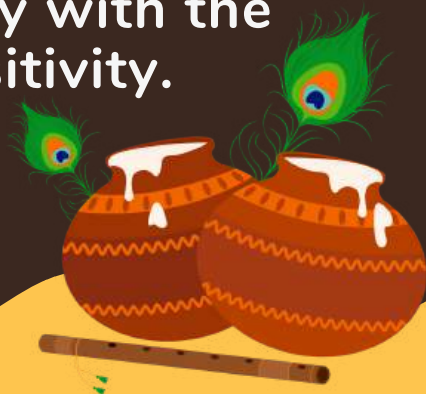

VINAYAGAR CHATHURTHI CELEBRATION

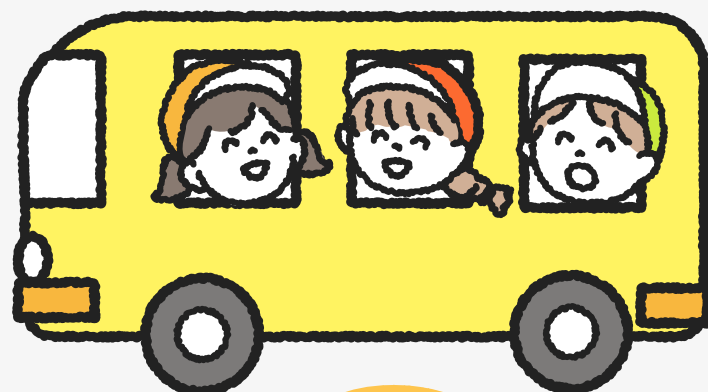
